CHARLESTOWN ROWING CLUB - 100 CLUB RULES

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the Charlestown Rowing Club bank account and used to fund equipment, resources, and opportunities for Club Members.

RULES

- 1. For a cost of £1 per month (i.e. per draw), you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100. You may purchase multiple numbers.
- 2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st and 2nd prize.
- 3. The target for the prizes will be approximately 50% of the annual income.
- 4. This will be apportioned as a 1st prize of £25 and a 2nd prize of £10 for each of all 12 months. In addition, there will be one special higher prize of £100 in the month of December.
- 5. If the number of Members exceeds 100, the prizes will be reviewed and increased accordingly
- 6. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all Members and friends of Charlestown Rowing Club. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
- 7. Payments must be made by standing order (monthly) or annual cheque. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
- 8. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, his or her number may be sold to another person.
- 10. The draw shall be made at the Club Committee meeting each month.
- 11. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application.
- 12. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the Club website.
- 13. The 100 Club will be run by the Club Committee. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Committee is final.
- 14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Club funds after six months.
