## CHARLESTOWN ROWING CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT



## 1. PURPOSE

- 1.1 Charlestown Rowing Club and its Members are committed to the Well Being and Safety of All. This code of conduct is to guide club Members in their responsibilities and duty of care.
- 1.2 Charlestown Rowing Club expects all members to follow this Code of Conduct at all times when representing the Club or engaged in the sport of Gig Rowing or associated activities.

## 2. CODE OF CONDUCT

- 2.1 Members must always consider the wellbeing of others and safety of all.
- 2.2 Members shall promote the positive aspects of our sport; both socially and in competition, especially those of Sportsmanship, Fair play, Friendship and Respect.
- 2.3 The Members will follow the Constitution, Policies, and Procedures of the Club and the Governing Body (Cornish Pilot Gig Association), including Child Protection, Health and Safety, Sea Safety, Water Safety Code, Racing Rules etc. (See <u>www.charlestownrowingclub.org.uk</u> for full list of Club Policies and Procedures)
- 2.4 Members should encourage all club members to value their performance and those of others, not just the results.
- 2.5 Members will not actively undermine the club; it's General Committee and members in their activities or deliberately seek to bring the club into disrepute.
- 2.6 Members will be prepared to accept responsibility for their actions.
- 2.9 Members shall set a good example to all, behave well in competitions, accept the Umpires decision, maintain composure at all times.
- 2.10 Members shall respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants in the sport regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 2.11 Members shall demonstrate proper standards of behaviour, language and manner when participating in Club activities or representing the club. Typically Members shall not:
  - Push people beyond their physical capabilities
  - Publicly ridicule any person, or swear at, or insult any person
  - Make racist, sexual or suggestive comments, even in fun
  - Allow Junior Members to do any of the above without intervention
